#### **GUIDELINES AND RULES**

- 1. Entries close 9am Monday 14th February 2022
- All competitors must include proof of registration or foal recording for each horse entered (e.g., a copy of the registration certificate) and proof of membership with all applicable societies (e.g., a copy of your membership card). Incomplete entries will not be processed, and entry will be refused on the day
- 3. Entry fees are \$8.00 per class, plus a compulsory venue fee of \$12.50 per horse
- Competitors, handlers and spectators MUST be double vaccinated in order to attend the venue.
- All competitors (including handlers) are required to complete an Exhibitor Waiver
- No refunds on entries under any circumstances after the closing date for entry fees, facility fee, stables/camping and/or sponsorship.
- 7. No refunds will be given for classes missed.
- Officials have the power to disqualify or remove competitors if instructions are not obeyed.
- Any competitor removed from competition may also have prize money withheld.
- 10. All horses at the event are kept under proper control at all times
- Official photographers will be present on the day of the show and no other professional/non-professional are permitted to offer their services to competitors.
- 12. Photographs may be taken on Show Day and maybe published in relevant media outlets as part of a record of the Show. In signing the Entry Form, you are agreeing to the publication of said photos. If you do not wish to have your Pony photographed, you must submit a letter, with your Entry Form to the Show secretary
- Ribbons are awarded to 6th place (except where otherwise specified) with lots of lovely garlands for Supremes
- The ABSS is not responsible for any damage or loss of property and all exhibitors compete at their own risk
- 15. No dogs are allowed in the stable area or on the competition arena, please leave at home or in the float at all times. Dogs must be walked on a leash and be picked up after
- Classes may be combined / split at the discretion of Event Officials / Stewards / Judges

#### **RULES FOR HORSES**

- 17. Exhibits are to be shown according to their breed standard
- 18. All colts that are 2 years old and over must be bitted or wear a chain and must be handled by a person over 17 years of age

- All colts must wear a green disc that is clearly visible to other competitors
- Exhibits deemed at risk to other exhibits or exhibitors will be asked to leave the ring and no refund on entries will be given
- 21. No horse feed permitted on the arena or track
- Cruelty to, or the abuse of any animal, by any person at this event is forbidden and an offender may be subject to withdrawal from further event classes.
- Youngstock must compete in the ring on their own. No mares or companions may enter the ring

#### **RULES FOR EXHIBITORS**

- 24. All horse owners are required to provide a Property Identification Code (PIC) relating to the property where the horse is kept <a href="http://agriculture.vic.gov.au/agriculture/farm-management/national-livestock-identification-system/property-identification-code/livestock-property-identification-codes">http://agriculture.vic.gov.au/agriculture/farm-management/national-livestock-identification-system/property-identification-code/livestock-property-identification-codes</a>. Applications are free and can be done online
- The ABSS Committee reserves the right to refuse entry or reject a competitor's entries
- 26. The Judge's decision will be final and Judges must not be approached on the day of the show by competitors or their associates
- 27. No contacting judges before or after the event. No adding judge on social media. Proof provided to committee will result in banning of any ABSS events.
- Competitors should not address the judge by name. All contact from competitor to the judge should be conducted through the steward
- 29. No exhibitor may show:
  - a. An exhibit bred by or leased from the judge or their family in the ring which the judge is officiating
  - An exhibit purchased from the judge or their family in the ring in which the judge is officiating, until after a period of 12 months
  - An exhibit in a class under the judge who has produced an animal for that exhibitor in the previous 12 months
  - An exhibit that is sponsored by the judge or their family members
- All competitors must wear suitable footwear. No open toe shoes allowed
- 31. All competitors and their associates must behave in an appropriate manner towards judges, stewards, show organisers and other competitors during the event. Abusive behaviour, bad

sportsmanship and bullying will not be tolerated. Any inappropriate behaviour reported by judges or stewards and/or witnessed by a member of the organising committee may result in elimination from the event and banned from any future events within the ABSS

#### **COVID-SAFE RULES**

As a condition of entry, competitors, essential helpers, Event Officials and volunteers should observe the following measures whilst on the grounds. Failure to comply with the following COVID-19 rules may result in elimination, removal from the grounds, and exclusion from all future ABSS events.

- 32. All persons attending MUST sign in using the QR code or register
- 33. Persons from restricted areas or those exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms MUST not attend or participate. Please ensure you check current Government guidelines before submitting entries and/or attending
- **34.** Hand sanitiser will be available throughout the venue, please use it regularly and practice good hand washing practices
- 35. Where possible, physical distancing (1.5m) should be maintained
- Please observe COVID-Safe signage around the grounds, including density limits

#### **PROTESTS**

- 37. An exhibitor / competitor may protest an award won by an exhibitor / competitor in the same class alleging infringement of the rules or ineligibility

Horse sports are dangerous recreational activities and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

#### By signing this waiver I acknowledge that:

- 1.1 participation in horse sports is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
- 1.2 participation in horse sports requires certain skills. I declare that I have sufficient skills to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
- 1.3 horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises;
- 1.4 if held at an agricultural show, the horse sports will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten horses;
- 1.5 as the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me and to my horse as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
